We would like to show easYgens generator power factor $\cos\phi$ via analog output on an external instrument .

For this we use easYgen's analog output 6 (0-20mA).

The analog display has an input of 0-10V.

0-10V voltage we are getting by adding a 500Ω resistor. ($I=U/R$)

PF 0,5 kap. 0mA 0V

PF 1 10mA 5V

PF 0,5 ind. 20mA 10V

Please add 01.20 Gen PF % in the AnalogManager of ToolKit and set the min and max values accordingly.

In your example it would look like this...
(50% =5V= corresponds to PF=1)
